## Drama techniques



### freeze frame

Pressing pause on a live performance – usually this is the most exciting moment, or the most dangerous, or the funniest. – You are frozen and stand completely still.



### mime

Silently acting a character showing emotions using only the face and body language.



### thought tracking

Speaking out the inner thoughts of the character. Usually completed during a freeze frame. Only **one** character at a time.



### narrator

A section of the story is spoken. There may be some action happening at the same time. This is usually spoken directly to the audience.



### flashback

The performance jumps back in time to provide the audience with further insight of the narrative.



Also known as cross-cutting.
